(ii) Storage of Chemicals & Diesel.

1. After review of Initial Environmental Examination (IEE) Report, SIR by DOE and other relevant record, the Environmental Protection Agency, Punjab has decided to accord permission for the storage of above-mentioned material at M/S Combined Fabrics limited warehouse located at Atta Buksh road, 17-Km Ferozepur Road, District Lahore subject to the following conditions:-

- i. The proponent shall ensure compliance of National Environmental Quality Standards (NEQS).
- ii. The proponent shall comply with the conditions of EPA and fulfill requirements of Civil Defense and Ministry of Petroleum.
- iii. The proponent shall maintain the documentation / record. Proper documentation of the materials shall be done which can be monitored randomly by District Officer Environment.
- iv. Mitigation Measures suggested in the IEE report and Environmental Management Plan (EMMP) shall be strictly adhered to minimize any negative impacts on soil, ground water, air and biological resources of the project area. The proponent will depute staff to monitor compliance of EMMP.
- v. Monitoring shall be carried out during the entire period of the project activities. Monitoring reports of whole operation shall be submitted to EPA, Punjab on monthly basis.
- vi. The solid waste management shall be done according to the satisfaction of this department which shall be monitored randomly. The proponent shall dispose off solid waste in a proper way also in consultation with TMA / District Government.
- vii. The proponent shall confine his activities within the boundary limits.
- viii. The proponent shall ensure that strict and efficient health and safety measures are in place for protection of workers backed by a comprehensive emergency response system.
- ix. The standby power generator shall be installed (if required) adopting sound proofing techniques and it shall be equipped with chimney with proper height to discharge the hot gases / smoke.
- x. The proponent shall obtain NOCs / approvals from the District Government and all other relevant departments including OGRA before commencement of work.
- xi. Extensive tree plantation, especially of indigenous species, must be carried out in and around the project area.
- xii. The proponent shall made necessary arrangements for controlling surface run off and contamination of surface / subsurface water bodies.
- xiii. The proponent shall obtain separate approval for Ministry of Climate Change, Islamabad in case of import of any material.
- xiv. The proponent shall do proper landscaping after completion of the project.
- xv. Proper ventilation will be provided in the dispensing / outlet area.

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- xvi. The proponent shall ensure disposal of solid / hazardous waste in a proper scientific way.
- xvii. The instructions for the workers, safety signs, precautionary / preventive measures for the customers / visitors shall be displayed at suitable / prominent places.
- xviii. The emergency phone numbers of hospitals, fire stations, nearest police stations, rescue services, and civil defense will be displayed at prominent places.
- xix. The reservoirs shall have at least 8ft displacement from the boundary walls.
- xx. There shall be proper arrangement to handle the accidental spillage.
- xxi. The building infrastructure will have proper ventilation and means of emergency system and the construction activity will be confined within boundary limits adopting Environmental Protection measures.
- xxii. Proper fire fighting arrangements shall be ensured in consultation with Civil Defense Academy / Department.
- xxiii. The proponent should be responsible for the safe transportation of chemicals in accordance with International Standards.

5. The proponent shall be liable for correctness and validity of information supplied to the environmental consultant.

6. The proponent shall be liable for compliance of Regulations 13, 14, 17 and 18 of IEE/EIA Regulations, 2000, regarding approval, confirmation of compliance, entry, inspections and monitoring.

7. Any change in the approved project shall be communicated to EPA, Punjab and shall be commenced after obtaining the approval.

9. This approval shall be treated as null and void if all or any of the conditions mentioned above, is /are not complied with. This approval does not absolve the proponent of the duty to obtain any other approval or consent that may be required under any law in force and is subjudice to legal proceedings in any legal for a / court.



(Under Section 12 of PEPA, 1997 read with IEE/EIA Regulations, 2000)

1. Description of Project: Installation of Waste Water Treatment Plant with 1200m³/day capacity
2. Location of Project: The project site is located at Charar Drain, Off 17-Km Ferozepur Road, District Lahore
3. Date of receiving 12.12.2013.
4. After review of Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) Report, Site Inspection Report by District Officer (Environment) and other relevant record, the Environmental Protection Agency, Punjab accord approval for installation of the above mentioned plant at the aforementioned site, to safeguard the environmental issues subject to the following conditions:

- i. The proponent shall install wastewater treatment plant in compatible with NEQS and also shall construct sanitary landfill site for safe disposal of sludge /solid waste in a scientific way.
- ii. The proponent shall ensure compliance of National Environmental Quality Standards (NEQS).
- iii. Mitigation Measures suggested in the EIA report and Environmental Management Plan (EMP) and Monitoring Plan shall be strictly adhered to minimize any negative impacts on soil, ground water, air and biological resources of the project area.
- iv. Monitoring shall be carried out during the entire period of the project activities. Monitoring reports of the whole operation shall be submitted to EPA, Punjab on monthly basis.
- v. The proponent shall not discharge untreated wastewater in a surface or sub-surface water body.
- vi. The proponent shall obtain prior permission from the concerned authority for effluent disposal and shall lay down a pipe line for safe disposal of treated wastewater into the municipal waste water channel.
- vii. The proponent shall plant at least 3000 fruit trees of minimum height 6-7 feet especially of indigenous species in the area within six months. The proponent will also take measures for the protection and maintenance of these trees.
- viii. The proponent shall obtain NOC / clearance from all other concerned departments including TMA before commencement of work.
- ix. The proponent shall appoint Environmental Manager (having at least qualification of BS. Environment Sciences) for the project and shall convey his / her name along with his complete Mailing Address and Phone Numbers.

5. The proponent shall be liable for correctness and validity of information supplied to this department by the consultant.
6. The proponent shall be liable for compliance of Regulations 13, 14, 17 and 18 of IEE/EIA Regulations, 2000, regarding approval, confirmation of compliance, entry, inspections and monitoring.
7. This approval is accorded only for the construction phase of the project. The proponent shall obtain approval for operational phase of the project in accordance with Regulation 13(2) (b) and Regulation 18 of the IEE/EIA Regulations, 2000.





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
